THE ALASKA ULU KNIFE (*pronounced oo-loo*) has been used for centuries by Native people of the Arctic. Ulus were first made from slate, a stone that is often found in a natural curved or tapered shape. It was this natural stone formation which inspired the unique Ulu design. Used to skin, fillet, sew, and eat, the Ulu was and still is their most popular cutting tool.

Today the Ulu has become a familiar sight in many modern kitchens. The Ulu performs culinary chores with ease and efficiency. From chopping nuts to slicing meats and cheese, the unique design of the Ulu makes these kitchen chores simple and easy. Fishermen and hunters have also found the Ulu to be their best cutting tool; it excels at cleaning and filleting fish and dressing game.

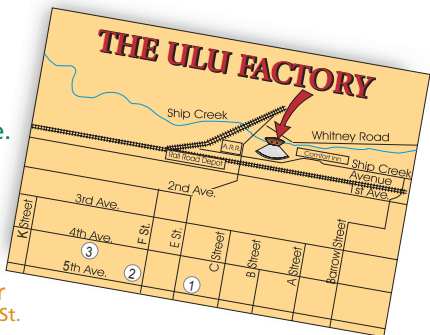
Come Ride Lolley the Trolley!
